What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Russell Investments Sustainable Global Shares Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. FundRock NZ Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

Objective: To provide a total return, before costs and tax, in line with the MSCI ACWI Index Net ('Benchmark') over the long term.

Strategy: The Fund invests predominantly in a broad range of international shares listed on stock exchanges in developed and emerging international markets. The Fund targets a reduction in carbon exposure, and an increase in exposure to renewable energy, compared to the Benchmark. The Fund also employs certain investment exclusions. Derivatives may be used to obtain or reduce exposure to securities and markets, to implement investment strategies and to manage risk. Foreign currency exposures are unhedged.

What are the risks of investing?^{See note 1}

Risk indicator for the Russell Investments Sustainable Global Shares Fund.



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

How has the fund performed?

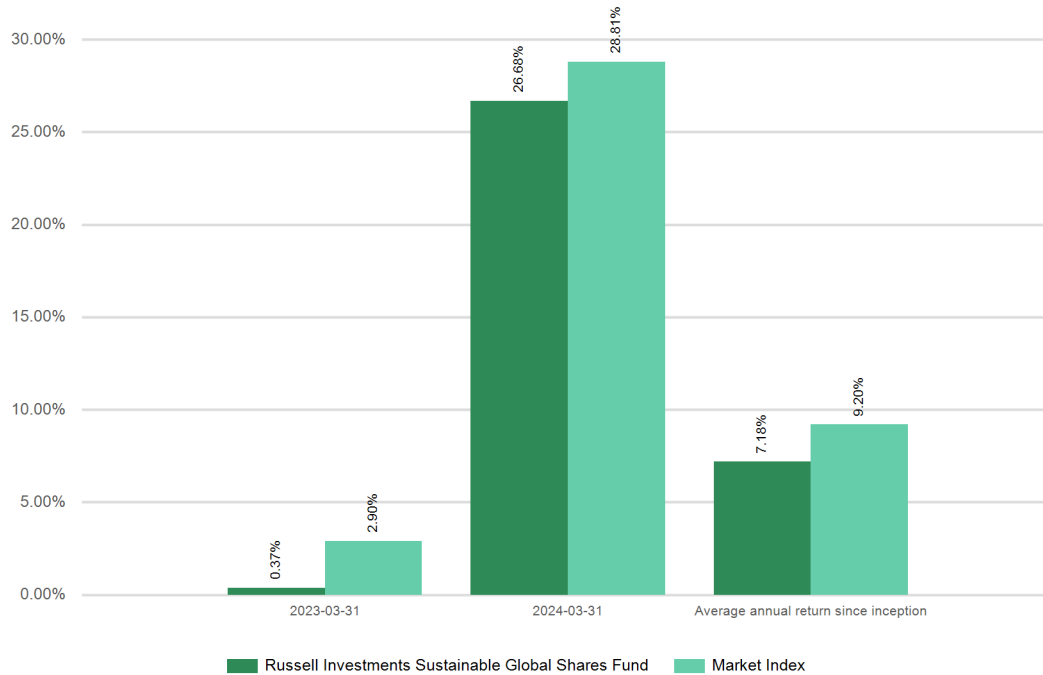

Example of how this applies to an investor

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

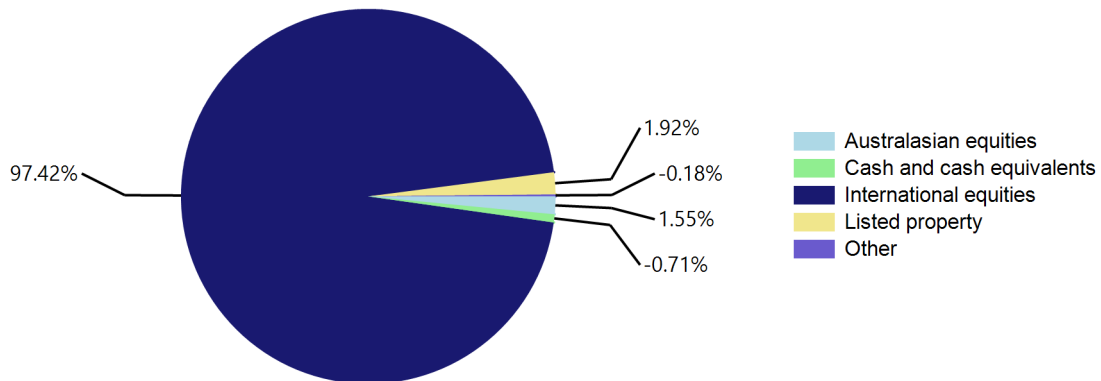
Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Anthony received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$2,446 (that is 24.46% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a return after tax of \$2,259 for the year.

This shows the types of assets that the fund invests in.

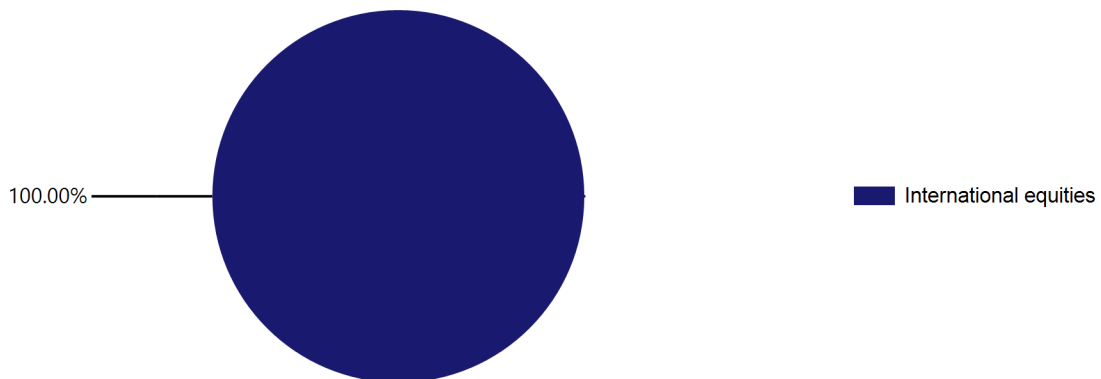
Actual Investment Mix

Notes

1. A combination of actual fund returns, and Market index returns have been used to determine the risk indicator as the fund has not been operating for the required five years. Market index returns have been used until 31 December 2021 and fund returns thereafter. The risk indicator may therefore provide a less reliable indicator of the fund's future volatility.
2. The bar chart shows fund returns after deducting fees and tax. Tax is deducted at the highest Prescribed Investor Rate of 28%. However, the market index returns are shown before deducting fees and tax.
