



# Fund Update For the quarter ended 30 June 2023

#### What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Vision Income Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. FundRock NZ Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

#### **Description of this fund**

Objective: The investment objective is to generate returns (after fees but before tax) that are above the median 1 year gross term deposit rate paid by the registered New Zealand banks.

Strategy: The fund is intended to provide members of the Brethren community (Community) with an investment product that suitably satisfies the Community's ethical requirements, as an alternative to other fixed income investments in the market. The fund will make loans to businesses in the Community, and may make investments in other fixed income investments and cash and cash-like investments. The fund may also invest in other credit funds or collective investment vehicles whose investments include loans made to the Community.

#### What are the risks of investing?<sup>1</sup>



#### Example of how this applies to an investor


Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Anthony received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$496 (that is 4.96% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a total return after tax of \$355 for the year.
